GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE: Created by the Board of Park Commissioners
- This Committee has no authority over operations of the golf course and acts only in an advisory capacity to the Board of Park Commissioners and staff members.
- MEMBERSHIP: Six members to be appointed by the Board of Park Commissioners. This number may be increased or decreased from time to time by the Board.
- CHAIRPERSON: Designated by the Committee should it be determined necessary.
- TERMS OF OFFICE: This Committee will be in effect for the duration of the study, meeting as needed; and upon completion will be reinstated as deemed necessary with each member serving a maximum of three (3) years with reappointment possible should vacancies exist. This is not a standing committee of the Board of Park Commissioners.
- SCOPE:
- A. Study the phases of the golf operations and make recommendations to the Board that are in the best interest of the Park District Golf Course.
 - B. Study and make recommendations on the maintenance of a total golf course and clubhouse operation that will benefit and serve the residents of the Deerfield Park District.
 - C. Study and make recommendations as to the improvement of the playability of the course.
 - D. Study and make recommendations regarding additional means of utilizing the course and clubhouse.

- E. Study and make recommendations concerning additional or new programming ideas that could be beneficial to the overall golf program.
- F. Study and make recommendations on the quality of the golf environment and physical plant.
- G. Study the current fee structure submitting recommendations to further enhance the delivery system to the public at a reasonable rate while maintaining sound fiscal management.
- H. Study methods of alternate sources of revenue.
- I. Act as a forum for citizens to express their thoughts and ideas concerning the course.

METHOD OF SELECTION:

Through direct correspondence with press releases, word of mouth, etc., residents will be asked to come forward to serve on the committee.

If no volunteers come forward, the next step shall be recruitment by the Board and staff members of individuals they feel would best serve the committee well. Final appointment will be made by the Board of Park Commissioners.

PARK DISTRICT LIAISON:

It is imperative that a representative of the Board of Park Commissioners and the Director of Parks and Recreation, along with other staff members assigned, serve in an advisory capacity to provide pertinent background information as needed, and serve as a liaison between the Board of Park Commissioners and the Golf Advisory Committee.
