

Minutes of the Workshop Meeting Board of Park Commissioners **April 1, 2010**

The Workshop Meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners was called to order by President Patinkin at 7:30 p.m. in the Administrative Offices of the Deerfield Park District located in the Jewett Park Community Center. Attendance was taken and the following were:

And there was a quorum in attendance. Also in attendance was Linda Gryziecki, Secretary/Executive Director; Don Bott, staff member.


Discussion followed on revisions made to the proposed renovation plan for Woodland Park. Per request of the Village Plan Commission, the park entrance off of School Street has been realigned to line up with Hertel Lane (west of Wilmot Road). The shelter/restroom facility and playground area have been rotated in order to allow a view of the park from the shelter. The use of recycled building/concrete materials in gabion seat walls was reviewed. Commissioners asked if bricks from the former school building could be used on the exterior with cut-up concrete on the inside. Staff will get more information on this as well as where the circulated pictures were taken. While there were mixed feelings on proceeding with the gabion seat walls, they will be presented to the Plan Commission with the other sustainable practices. They can always be removed from the plan and seat walls constructed out of other materials.

Commissioners reviewed options for the proposed playground.

Discussion followed on the Draft Intergovernmental Agreement with revisions proposed.

There being no further business, at 10:00 p.m. the Workshop Meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners was adjourned.
